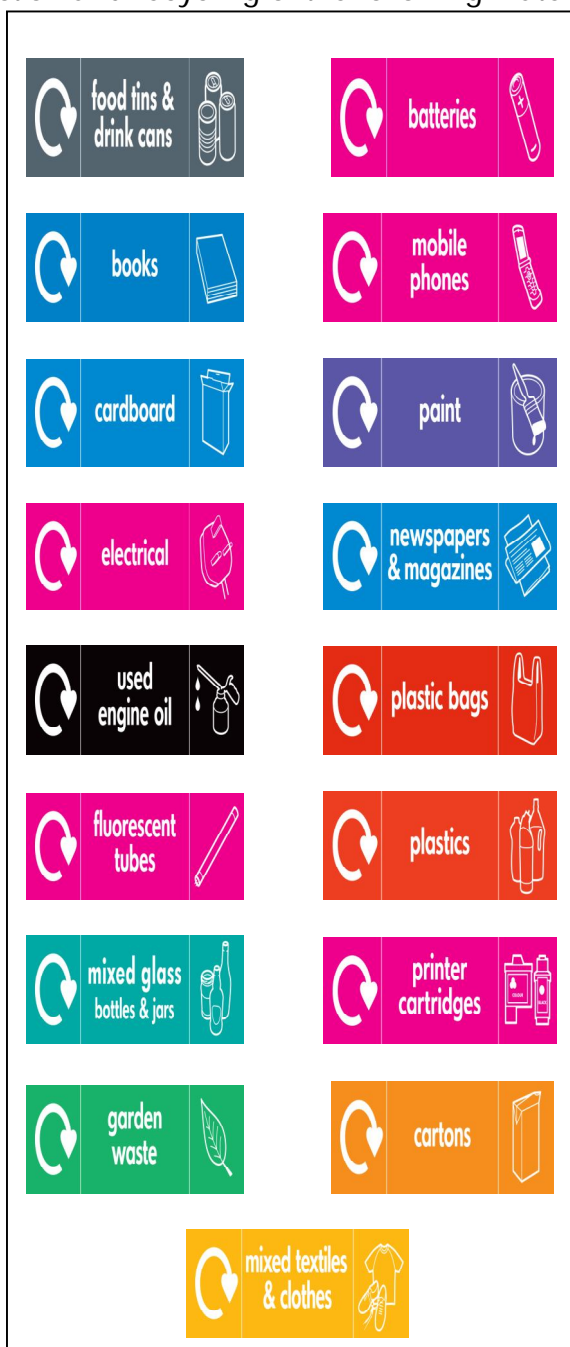


Civic Amenity Sites

The two civic amenity sites in Ballymoney Borough are located at **Burnquarter Road** and **Knock Road**, where you can dispose of bulky waste, garden waste and recyclable materials from your home.

Both civic amenity sites allow for the collection and recycling of the following materials:

- ❑ Aerosols
- ❑ Aluminium cans
- ❑ Books and music
- ❑ Car batteries
- ❑ Cardboard
- ❑ Cooking oil
- ❑ Electrical equipment
- ❑ Engine oil
- ❑ Fluorescent light tubes
- ❑ Fridges and freezers
- ❑ Gas cylinders
- ❑ Glass containers
- ❑ Green waste
- ❑ Household batteries
- ❑ Mobile phones
- ❑ Paint tins[empty]
- ❑ Paper & magazines
- ❑ Plastic bags
- ❑ Plastic containers with screw tops
- ❑ Printer cartridges
- ❑ Scrap metal
- ❑ Tetra Paks
- ❑ Textiles



Customers with larger loads of materials e.g. garden waste or cardboard should use Burnquarter Road for their own convenience.

In response to requests from site users, both locations now have blue cardboard compactors. These are immediately identifiable and are part of a plan to recover as much waste as possible from landfill.

Your cooperation is requested, specifically in putting food wastes in plastic bags and then in the black compactor at Knock Road and dedicated skip at Crosstagherty.

Our civic amenity sites are designed to help you manage your waste. As our facilities develop, we can now recycle more items, meaning less is buried in landfill sites. We ask for your cooperation in placing items in the appropriate containers or skips.

Our staff are on site to assist you if you have any questions or require assistance in removing items from your car or trailer. Users of both sites should be aware that both sites see large volumes of traffic and therefore should be conscious of health and safety at all times.
