353.1 BALLYMONEY SPORTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Chairman welcomed representatives of the Ballymoney Sports Advisory Committee, Mr Thomas Skelton and Mr Richard Gormley and invited them to make their presentation. Mr Skelton thanked members for the opportunity to give their annual report (attached as Appendix 1) and in conclusion answered members' questions.

Alderman Connolly paid tribute to Mr Thomas Skelton, Richard Gormley and John Faul for the amount of work they do on behalf of the Sports Advisory Committee and in particular the Sports Awards' event.

Before he left the meeting Councillor Robinson congratulated Mr Skelton and Dalriada High School on being awarded the Sunday Times Northern Ireland School of The Year. Other members also congratulated Dalriada High School on its award.

353.3 LEISURE SERVICES – CAPITAL PROJECTS 2008/09 UPDATE

The Director advised that all the undernoted projects have commenced and the expected completion dates are as listed beside each project.

353.4 JOEY DUNLOP LEISURE CENTRE - MAINTENANCE PROGRAMME

The Director advised that in order to facilitate maintenance works the following areas of the Leisure Centre will be closed as specified –

Swimming Pool & Changing Rooms – closed from 14th December
Heath Suite & Changing Rooms – closed from 15th December

In order for the capital project works to be undertaken the Sports Halls will be closed from 1st December 2008.

The Director advised that she hoped that all facilities will be open as “normal” on Monday 29th December 2008.

353.5 MUSEUM FIT – OUT – AUDIO VISUAL AND IT HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE

The Director advised that the five companies that formed the select list were invited to tender for the Audio – Visual and IT Hardware and Software. The closing date for the receipt of tenders was 13th November 2008.

Only 2 tenders were returned and these were opened by the Chair of Committee and the Director and sent to the consultants, Hayley Sharpe Design to be checked for completeness and accuracy and evaluated.

The tenders were received from Atacama, Bristol and Spiral Productions, London. The Consultant’s recommend acceptance of the most economic tender that from Atacama in the amount o £56,455. The Director advised that this price was well within the budget for the works.

It was proposed by Alderman Cousley, seconded by Alderman Connolly and
AGREED:

to recommend that Council accept the tender from Atacama for the Museum Fit –Out, Audio Visual and IT hardware and software in the amount of £56,455.00.

The Director advised that she would be arranging a meeting of the Museum Working Group to discuss the progress of the contract, the opening of the exhibition and the draft Exhibition Policy.

It was **AGREED** that the date for the meeting would be fixed at the Council Meeting on 1st December.

Discussion ensued regarding the membership of the Working Group, after which, it was proposed by Councillor Robinson, seconded by Councillor Stevenson and

to recommend that Alderman Cousley be appointed to the Museum Working Group.
